With students traveling through the building daily, specifically with belongings from home, schools have an increased risk of pest infestations. To ensure that your classroom stays pestfree, please use the following tips to make sure that you aren't inviting pests like ants, flies, cockroaches, bed bugs, or rodents into your students learning space.

- Remove trash from your room regularly
- Keep all food items in tightly sealed containers
- Quickly clean any spills or crumbs with a disinfectant
- Report any leaks to maintenance immediately
- Keep your classroom tidy and clutter free
- Keep backpacks and lunch boxes off the ground
- Ensure there are no tears in window screens and keep windows closed as much as possible
- Report pest related complaints to the main office or authorized official

Most importantly, please inform the front office staff of any signs of pest activity in a timely manner. The earlier an issue is discovered, the quicker we can resolve the problem.
